

Who Needs Driver CPC?

Are all drivers required to undertake initial qualification (Driver CPC)?

No. If you hold a bus licence prior to 10th September 2008 or a lorry licence prior to 10th September 2009 you will have the acquired rights and will need to complete 35 hours of Periodic Training (Driver CPC) and you will not have to pass the initial qualification.

New drivers who pass their theory and practical test (Modules 1 & 3) for either C1, C, D1 or D categories after the date of CPC implementation (as above) will be required to complete the CPC theory and practical test (Modules 2 & 4).

What does the initial qualification for new drivers involve?

It will involve 4 Modules:

Theory Test:

• Module 1a	- 100 multiple choice questions	£35.00
• Module 1b	- 19 hazard perception clips	£15.00
• Module 2	- initial driver CPC – 3 case studies	£30.00

Practical Tests:

• Module 3	- practical driving test	£115.00
• Module 4	- initial driver CPC practical demonstration test	£55.00

Until 'new drivers' complete Modules 2 & 4 (Initial Qualification Tests) they cannot driver for commercial purposes (hire and reward).
