



## Who Needs The Driver CPC Periodic Training (35 hours)

If you took a driving test on a **DI or D** (PCV) vehicle **before 10th September 2008**

or

You hold or took a test on a **CI, C or CE** (LGV) vehicle **before 10th September 2009**

You have the acquired rights and need to complete **35 hours of 'Periodic Training'** and complete before 9th October 2013 (PCV) and 9th October 2014 (LGV)

### Driver CPC Periodic Training (Initial Qualification Card)

If you took a driving test on a **DI or D** (PCV) vehicle **after 10th September 2008**

or

If you took a test on a **CI, or C** (LGV) vehicle **after 10th September 2009**

**You must take the Initial Driver CPC Modules 2 & 4**

### Areas of Confusion

If you took your car test after 1997 you only received a Cat B entitlement and not the 'Grand Father Rights' of CI and DI. In order to gain these additional categories you must have taken the appropriate CI, C or DI tests. This is why trainers ask to see the rear of the photo ID licence to check the start date to decide if you are in the 'Periodic' category of the 'Modular' category.
